1. Preliminary Feasibility Results

The presentation shown at the public meeting described the criteria and weighting factors used to evaluate the feasibility of two different routes for the PHNST: the blue route as close to the river on public right-of-way and parkland as possible, and, the orange route providing alternative inland routes for connecting between destinations along the Potomac River. The preliminary results are shown on displays 4 through 8.

Do you agree or disagree with the preliminary findings? Is any specific segment a concern for you?

2. Priorities for Implementation

Trail development projects are going to be implemented over time. Some projects may only require placement of signs and repairing an existing route. Other projects may take many years to first gain funding, then design and permitting, followed by a construction phase.
